**A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLINDA CITY COUNCIL TO ESTABLISH UNIFORM
SERVICING WITHIN THE CITY OF GOLINDA BY THE WACO MCLENNAN
COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the City of Golinda is a Type A Incorporated Municipality whose geographic boundaries are located within both McLennan and Falls Counties;

WHEREAS, the geographic area within McLennan County is serviced by the Waco-McLennan County Public Health District and the geographic area within Falls County is serviced by Falls County and the State of Texas;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City and the residents for the entire geographic area of the City to be serviced by one entity;

WHEREAS, the City Attorney, at the direction of the City Council, on behalf of the City of Golinda, has initiated communication with the Waco-McLennan County Public Health District and Falls County to develop a uniform servicing plan within the City of Golinda;

WHEREAS, the City Attorney reports that Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has informally consented to begin servicing the geographic areas within the City of Golinda that is located within the geographic areas of Falls County and that Falls County has informally consented to such service by the Public Health District;


WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City for the Waco-McLennan County Public Health District to service the entire geographic area of the City of Golinda;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLINDA, TEXAS:

1. The City of Golinda, Texas hereby seeks to amend its agreement with the Waco-McLennan County Public Health District to provide services within the Geographic Boundaries of Golinda, Texas.
2. The City Attorney is directed and authorized to communicate with the Waco-McLennan County Public Health District, Falls County, and any other person or entity to secure the amended agreement for services with the Waco-McLennan County Public Health District.
3. The City Attorney is directed and authorized to develop any and all documentation to facilitate and secure the amended agreement for services with the Waco-McLennan County Public Health District.

4. The City Attorney is directed and authorized to seek approval from the Waco-McLennan County Public Health District, Falls County, and any of person or entity to secure the amended agreement for services with the Waco-McLennan County Public Health District and upon obtaining all approval shall present said documentation to the City Council for final approval.
