

RESOLUTION No. 071321

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLINDA CITY COUNCIL TO ESTABLISH UNIFORM LOCAL REGULATION OF ON-SITE SEWAGE FACILITIES WITHIN THE CITY OF GOLINDA

WHEREAS, the City of Golinda, Texas is a Type A Incorporated Municipality whose geographic boundaries are located within both McLennan and Falls Counties;

WHEREAS, The City Council has previously passed Resolution 062519 wherein it was found that it in the best interest of the City and the residents for the entire geographic area of the City to be serviced by one public health entity and that it best to seek servicing by the Waco-McLennan County Public Health District (District);

WHEREAS, part of the public health service relates to the on-site sewage facilities, i.e. septic tanks (OSSF) and that said service is entirely regulated by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) but administered by local authorized agents;

WHEREAS, the current authorized agents are McLennan and Falls Counties for their respective geographic areas and that McLennan County contracts with the District for administration of its area;


WHEREAS, it has been determined that the City of Golinda could become a TCEQ authorized agent for OSSF regulation and then contract directly with the District; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that seeking such designation and contracting with the District is in the best interest of the City and its residents and necessary for the public health.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLINDA, TEXAS:

1. The City Attorney and Mayor are authorized and directed to communicate with the Waco-McLennan County Public Health District, TCEQ, and any other necessary entity or person about the City becoming a local TCEQ OSSF authorized agent and the District contracting with the City to administer said regulation in the same manner that the District contracts with McLennan County.
2. The City Attorney is authorized and directed to prepare any and all necessary documents and to take any and all necessary procedures to accomplish the City becoming a local TCEQ OSSF authorized agent and the District contracting with the City to administer said regulation in the same manner that the District contracts with McLennan County.
