

## ORDINANCE NO. 108

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE CREATION OF ANY UNREASONABLE NOISE WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

### SECTION 1

#### Section 1 – UNREASONABLE NOISE PROHIBITED

The creation of any unreasonable loud, disturbing and unnecessary noise in the City of Golinda is hereby prohibited. Noise of such character, intensity and duration as are reasonably calculated to cause material distress, discomfort or injury to persons of ordinary sensibilities, or to be detrimental to the life or health of any ordinary reasonable person are hereby prohibited.

### SECTION 11

#### Section 2 – ENUMERATION OF SPECIFIC NOISES

The following acts, among others, are elected to be loud disturbing and unnecessary noise is violation of this ordinance; provided however, that such enumeration shall not be construed to be exclusive of other noises. To-wit:

- (a) The unnecessary sounding of any horn or signal device on any automobile, motorcycle, or other vehicle, while not in motion; the creation by means of any such signal device of any unreasonable loud or harsh sound; and the sounding of such device for an unreasonable period of time.
- (b) The playing of any radio, TV or any musical instrument in such manner, or with such volume, particularly during the hours between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. as to create a noise such as reasonably calculated to disturb a person of ordinary disposition under the same or similar circumstances residing in a dwelling or other type of residence in the vicinity. No stationary loud speaker or amplifier shall be operated between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
- (c) The use of loudspeakers or amplifiers on trucks or other vehicles except where specific license is granted.
- (d) The keeping of any animal which by causing frequent or long continued noise shall disturb the comfort and repose of any person of ordinary sensibilities in the immediate vicinity.

**SECTION 3 – PENALTY**

Any violation of this ordinance shall be declared to be a misdemeanor and the person violating the same shall be subject to a fine of not less than one dollar (\$1.00) nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00).
